The Men's Odyssey group was started 24 years ago by our past Reverend Webster Kitchell. The group now totals 17 men, and we encourage membership for participation but don't require it.

As Stated in our Covenant:

We gather for fellowship, mutual support, moral centering and spiritual growth. We hold meetings, share activities, gather for yearly retreats- and share from the heart.

We meet the first Tuesday of each month in the evening from 7-8:30pm in the UUSF Library. We begin with a Chalice lighting, followed by a check-in, then Discussion and end with the Serenity prayer.

We rotate Facilitators who have the responsibility to organize and choose a Topic for discussion. Some of the recent Discussions were:

A.I.; Conspiracy theories; Nanoscience; Letting go; Hell in theology; My life's journey; Cytogenetics; Music in my life; Neanderthal genome Project; How did I get here in life?; Certainty of an invisible force?; Silver linings; The Eerie; Risk Taking; and travel stories.

Each third Tuesday of the month we choose an activity- which may be at UUSF or other venue. In the past, it has been bowling, poker, pool, and bocce ball.

There has been a weekend retreat every Fall, traditionally at Ghost ranch.

Odyssey also considers Service to UUSF as part of our responsibility. For example, we help in Sunday parking lot security, help in outside grounds upkeep; and support various events such as the book sale, memorial services, and other social and fundraising events.
